

Course Coding System

The course code consists of a course title and a sixth character code: The first five characters are designated by the Ministry of Education and Training. The Algoma District School Board determines the sixth character.

1 st , 2 nd , and 3 rd	Subject discipline of the course in letters.	"ENG" English
4 th	Grade level as a number "1" Grade 9 "3" Grade 11 "2" Grade 10 "4" Grade 12	"1" Grade 9
5 th	Type of course as a letter "D" Academic "E" Workplace "P" Applied "C" College "O" Open "M" University/College "U" University "L" Locally Developed	"D" Academic course
6 th	Board designated character that indicates credit value or may be used to differentiate between courses with similar codes.	"B" International Baccalaureate and Enhanced Learning
