

READ AROUND THE WORLD PROGRAM

The **Read Around the World** program is a reading initiative that encourages students to read. Once the students have read a book that is not a part of the curriculum, they can enter it in the **Read Around the World** draw. Once a month there is a draw for pizza vouchers, coupons from the cafeteria, ELSS T-shirts, or \$25 worth of books that they select from chapters.indigo.ca. The student's name is also placed on a map of the world. Their name starts at Elliot Lake. Their name will move west an inch at a time until they circumnavigate the world and end back in Elliot Lake. The students must read 40 books to return to Elliot Lake. The first time around the world the student's name is white. The second time around their name is lemon. The third time it is orange and the fourth time it is green. Their journey starts in Grade 9 and continues until they leave high school.
