

**Dramatic Arts, Grade 10 Open (ADA20)**

This course requires students to actively explore dramatic forms and techniques, using their own ideas and concerns as well as sources selected from a wide range of authors, genres, and cultures. Student learning will include identifying and using the principles of space, time, voice, and movement in creating, sustaining, and communicating authentic roles within a drama. Students will assume responsibility for decisions made in the creation and presentation of the drama, and will analyse and reflect on the experience. Prerequisite: None *Alexander Henry, Bawating, CASS, SJD, Elliot Lake, Michipicoten, White Pines, and WC Eaket only*

**Music, Grade 10 Open (AMU20)**

This course emphasizes performance of music at an intermediate level that strikes a balance between challenge and skill. Student learning will include participating in creative activities and listening perceptively. Students will also be required to develop a thorough understanding of the language of music, including the elements, terminology, and history. Prerequisite: None *Bawating, CASS, Elliot Lake, Michipicoten, SJD, WC Eaket, Hornepayne, Korah, and White Pines only*

**Visual Arts, Grade 10 Open (AVI20)**

This course emphasizes learning through practice; building on what students know; and introducing them to new ideas, materials, and processes for artistic thinking and experimentation. Student learning will include the refined application of the elements and principles of design, incorporating the creative and design processes, and the relationship between form and content. Students will also learn about the connections between works of art and their historical contexts. Course objectives may be achieved either through a comprehensive program or through a program focused on a particular art form (e.g., drawing, painting). Prerequisite: None - AVI10 recommended. *All schools except Chapleau and Hornepayne*
