

**Dramatic Arts, Grade 11 Open (ADA30)**

This course requires students to create and to present dramatic works. Students will do research on and study such types of contemporary theatre as docudrama and forum theatre. They will interpret and present works in a variety of dramatic forms; create and script original works; analyse and reflect on dramatic works; and develop their communication skills and other skills useful in a variety of careers. Prerequisite: Dramatic Arts, Grade 9 or 10, Open *CASS, WC Eaket, SJD, Michipicoten, White Pines, and Elliot Lake only*

**Instrumental Music – Band, Grade 11 Open (AMI30)**

This course emphasizes individual performance as well as in ensemble playing. Musical styles such as jazz, classical and contemporary, will be explored in greater detail. Students will continue to further their knowledge of musical concepts and increase their music reading skills. Listening skills will be further developed and the compositional component will include using electronic instruments to write musical accompaniment. Prerequisite: AMU20 or permission of instructor. *Elliot Lake only*

**Guitar, Grade 11 Open (AMG30)**

This course is designed for students to continue, improve, and expand their knowledge of the guitar, technical patterns, and an understanding of chord vocabulary. The students of this course will be allowed to explore areas designed for their personal understanding. Prerequisite: Guitar, Grade 10, Open *Bawating, Elliot Lake, SJD, and White Pines only*

**Music, Grade 11 Open (AMU30)**

This course develops students' artistic knowledge and skills through the performance of music and the preparation of music productions. Students will perform appropriate works, particularly works in contemporary popular styles. Independently and in groups, they will also plan, market, and produce music productions, making use of appropriate technology, and will evaluate the results. Prerequisite: Music, Grade 9 or 10, Open *Elliot Lake, Hornepayne, and Michipicoten only*

**Music, Grade 11, University/College Preparation (AMU3M)**

This course emphasizes the appreciation, analysis, and performance of various kinds of music, including baroque and classical music, popular music, and Canadian and non-Western music. Students will perform technical exercises and appropriate repertoire, complete detailed creative activities, and analyse and evaluate live and recorded performances. They will continue to increase their understanding of the elements of music while developing their technical and imaginative abilities. Prerequisite: Music, Grade 9 or 10, Open *Bawating, CASS, Elliot Lake, Hornepayne, SJD, WC Eaket and White Pines only*

**Visual Arts, Grade 11, Open (AVI30)**

This course focuses on studio activities in one or more of the visual arts. Students will create art works that explore a wide range of subject matter, and will evaluate art works, providing grounds for their aesthetic judgements. They will also examine historical and cultural contexts of Western art (including Canadian art) and art from various world cultures to support their study of specific media. Prerequisite: Visual Arts, Grade 9 or 10, Open *Alexander Henry, CASS, Elliot Lake, Michipicoten and WC Eaket only*

**Visual Arts, Grade 11 University/College Preparation (AVI3M)**

This course provides students with opportunities to further develop their skills and knowledge in visual arts. Students will explore a range of subject matter through studio activities and will consolidate their practical skills. Students will also analyse art works and study aspects of Western art history from Mannerism to the Neoclassic period, as well as art forms from Canada and other parts of the world. Studio activities will include figure drawing, water colour painting, print making, sculpture, design, mixed media and computer-based projects. Prerequisite: Visual Arts, Grade 9 and/or 10 Open *Bawating, CASS, Elliot Lake, Korah, SJD, WC Eaket, and White Pines only*
